

Who is this programme for?

Cost:

Places on this programme are fully funded by Just Enterprise meaning there is no cost to learners.

Delivery Method:

This programme will be delivered with a combination of in person and online modules. The in person modules will be at The Melting Pot, 15 Carlton Road, Edinburgh. The online modules will be delivered using Zoom.

In between modules, you are encouraged and supported to put your learning into practice.
