It is specifically aimed at those who are keen to understand how to develop their leadership and enhance the role they can play at a more senior level.

Delivered with an interactive approach, you will work with and learn from peers to explore a range of practical concepts and approaches. The programme focuses very much on the practice of leadership at a senior level, helping you to gain greater personal insight, different perspectives and awareness.
